

AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT (ARRA)
STATE FISCAL STABILIZATION FUNDS (SFSF)

Center ISD will use Title XIV American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (www.recovery.gov), State Fiscal Stabilization Funds (SFSF) 2009-10 to construct a Career and Technology wing at Center High School. The construction will provide additional science labs, upgrade technology applications and provide facilities for health sciences and culinary arts/hospitality labs and classrooms.

The estimated construction cost for the project is \$2,725,380. The SFSF funds totaling \$1,311,688 will be expensed for the building project. The estimated completion date is February 2010. The SFSF infrastructure investment has received a full review and vetting as required by law. The use of the SFSF funds for the infrastructure investment of the construction of a Career and Technology wing is an appropriate and effective use of taxpayers' dollars to improve the education of the students of Center Independent School District.
