The meeting was called to order and the minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed and approved. Mr. Rodgers reviewed the district's mission statement and goals. The results of the evaluations from the October 30 meeting were shared with the committee.

Mr. Rodgers reviewed the committee's responsibilities for staffing patterns, staff development, planning, budgeting, school organization and curriculum.

Wes Kirkham gave the committee an update on the School Improvement Plan and also discussed the different high school activities going on now as well as recent accomplishments of students.

Mr. Rodgers reviewed the facilities committee's charge and goals. The school board has hired an architect and the facilities committee will meet again on February 6.

Pete Low presented a safety update to the committee. Each campus has done shelter-in-place drills and will possibly do more of those this year. Due to safety concerns, the district is researching ways to limit access to the parking areas on campuses.

Angela Lawson reviewed the parent involvement goals and reported on the success of the TAKS parent conferences recently held at the high school. Baby Lou Gardner and Rochelle McClelland assisted those two evenings and Mrs. Lawson thanked them for their help. Representatives from Ed Trust will be here again on March 2 and 3. Mrs. Lawson and Billie Sue Payne have met with two campuses to discuss the 40 Developmental Assets Program and will be meeting with the other campuses soon.

Campus principals reported on the following: campus activities, staff development, and accomplishments of students.

Mr. Rodgers told the committee that we will begin to plan for next school year at our next meeting. Needs assessments will be conducted to help determine the areas in which we need to focus.

Rayford Copelin presented the proposed 2007-2008-district calendar and the district's request for two waiver days, which were both approved by the committee. Those will be presented for approval at the regularly scheduled board meeting this month.

The next DEIC meeting will be March 26.
