CISD is required by law to inform staff and students when an individual who tests positive has been on campus within two days of developing symptoms or two days prior to testing positive, if asymptomatic.

Symptoms Include	
Cough	Sore throat
Chills/shaking/or exaggerated shivering	New onset loss of taste or smell
Significant muscle pain or aches	Unusual fatigue
Severe headache	Congestion or runny nose
Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing	Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
Feeling feverish or measured temperature greater than 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
